HADIZA M. MUHAMMAD

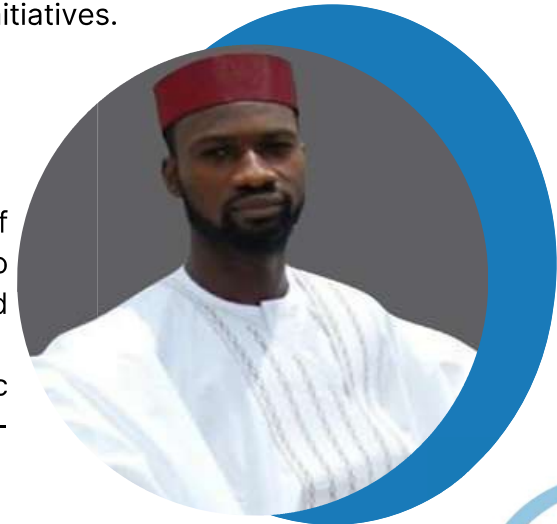

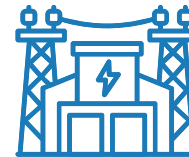
- Pay JAMB registration fee for 1,000 candidates every year for the next Ten (10) years across the (8) Local Government Areas of Zone A in Niger State.

Provision of operational Motor Vehicle and Motorcycles to support security as well as fencing of some Area Police Divisions and primary schools in the communities in the 8 LGAs.

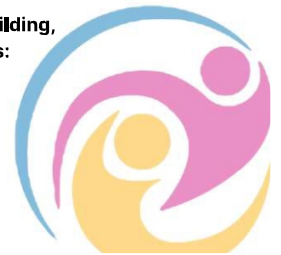

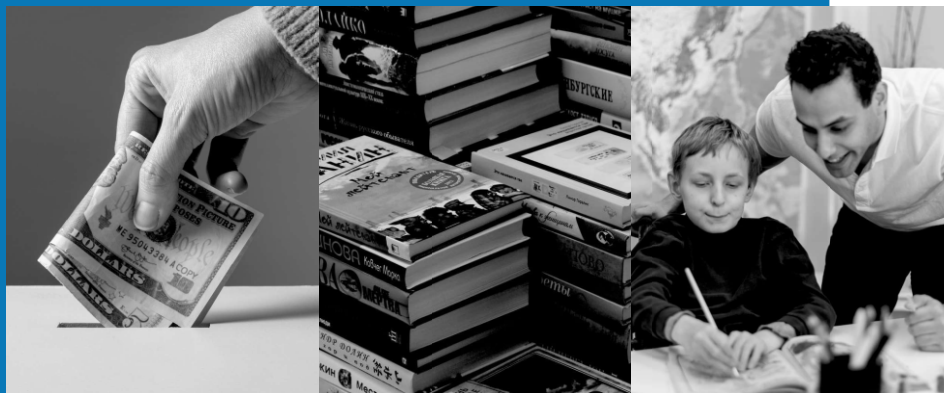
